Description: The museum is an eclectic mixture of children's playground, funhouse, surrealistic pavilion, and architectural marvel made out of unique, found objects. The brainchild of internationally acclaimed artist Bob Cassilly, a classically trained sculptor and serial entrepreneur, the museum opened for visitors in 1997 to the riotous approval of young and old alike.

A visitor of this place wrote this: "Words and pictures cannot adequately describe this place. It must be experienced to be understood. Wear jeans and closed toe shoes. You will be climbing, sliding, scooting and having a blast in this unique place. DO NOT miss this place if you are in St. Louis!"

Admission: Free! (Take Note: Children's Zoo, Stingrays Cove and Sea Lion Show are \$4/person, Zooline Railroad \$7.95 for all day.)

Parking: Free on the side of the road, or \$15 zoo parking

Location: South Parking Lot-- Forest Park, 4 Wells Dr, St. Louis, MO 63139 (\$15/vehicle)

Description: Voted America's top free attraction, the Zoo is located on 90 acres in beautiful Forest Park, and home to more than 603* species of animals, many of them rare and endangered. It is one of the few free zoos in the nation that has free admission.

The St. Louis Zoo is 3rd best zoo in the United States, and 4th best in the world per Trip Advisor's Traveller's Choice Awards.

Parking Note: If north and south lot are full, can go to overflow parking near <u>Berthold Ave and Clayton Ave St. Louis, MO</u>. Costs less (\$5), but a bit longer walk to zoo. Driver could drop everybody off at zoo, then park. Missouri Botanical Gardens (closes at 5 pm)

Admission Fee: \$12 adults (ages 13 & over) Children (ages 12 & under) have free admission.

Parking: Free. It's parking could get full. Might need to find street parking and walk a little farther.

Location: 4344 Shaw Blvd, St. Louis, MO 63110

Description: The 79 acres of splendid horticultural display at the Missouri Botanical Garden offers something for everyone. Outstanding displays include the Chinese Garden, English Woodland Garden, Ottoman Garden and Victorian District.

A vibrant tropical rainforest thrives inside the <u>Climatron</u> conservatory, while the adjoining <u>Temperate</u> <u>House</u> is home to a multitude of Mediterranean species. The <u>Japanese Garden</u> covers 14 acres, making it one of the largest Japanese strolling gardens in North America.

More than 4,800 trees live on the grounds, including some unusual varieties and a few stately specimens dating back to the 19th century, when Garden founder Henry Shaw planted them.

St Louis Science Center (closes at 5:30 pm)

Admission Fee: Free, but charge for Omnimax Theater, Discovery Room, etc.

Location: Museum parking (\$10): 5050 Oakland Ave, St. Louis, MO 63110

Description: The Science Center focuses on hands-on learning with exhibits, experiments and classes showcasing many different kinds of science. This is a particularly good educational experience for children. Find life-sized, animated models of a T-Rex and Triceratops, a fossil lab and exhibits on ecology and the environment. Experience the <u>Discovery Room</u> for kids, MakerSpace

The Gateway Arch Ticketing & Visitor Center has relocated to the Old Courthouse at 11 N. 4th Street St Louis MO. Please note the walking distance between the Old Courthouse and the Arch entrance at the NORTH leg is approximately 7.5 blocks (10-15 minutes of average walking time). **EACH guest planning to enter the Gateway Arch will be required to have EITHER a Journey to the Top ticket or an Arch Entry-Only ticket to be allowed access to the facility.** Tram tickets will sell out early and often in the Spring - advance tickets are strongly recommended.

You must have a ticket before going to the arch.

Todo list for going to the arch:

- purchase tickets at the Old Courthouse first before going to the Arch.
- also buy tickets in advance from http://gatewayarch.com/Visit/Buy-Tickets.aspx
- print-at-home option: print out your ticket and bring it directly to the arch.
- also print the e-mail you receive after purchasing your ticket, and present that at the arch.
- save the printout to your smartphone and show it to them on it (make sure your phone battery is charged).

- Arrive at the arch at least 30 minutes before your appointment to go to the top of the arch because of security.
- Tickets are for a specific time. I recommend you get a ticket for a time between 3:30 pm and 4:30 pm.

Sometimes the tickets for the tram can sell out!

It can be good to get the ticket online the day before (or sooner) to reserve your place visiting the arch (and riding the tram to the top). Can call 877-982-1410 ahead of time to make sure the tickets are not sold out. You can also buy tickets by calling 877-982-1410, and then pick your ticket at the Old Courthouse.

Security: The arch does have security screening at the entrance. You may have to wait in line to get inside. Should arrive 30 minutes before tram ticket time.

If you get a ticket for the tram, you will be given a time you can board. Make sure no one with a later time on their tram ticket is in front of you in line.

Creve Coeur Lake Memorial Park

Creve Coeur Lake Rentals, Creve Coeur Park Picnic Site 1, Marine Ave, Maryland Heights, MO 63043.

2,145-acre (8.68 km2) St. Louis County park located in Maryland Heights, Missouri, United States. The park is the largest in the St. Louis County Parks system and includes Creve Coeur Lake, an oxbow lake which is the largest natural lake in Missouri. The park has facilities for picnicking, tennis courts, multi-purpose athletic fields, a place to rent canoes (\$10-\$15 / hr), bicycles (\$10/hr), kayaks, etc. There's also a disc (Frisbee) golf course. (Bring your own Frisbee.)

Aldi's (cheapest): <u>11745 Olive Blvd, Creve Coeur, MO 63141</u> (Bare bones grocery store, but least expensive.) 13 minutes or so depending on time of day. Open 9am – 9pm every except Sunday (until 8pm).

Trader Joe's 11505 Olive Blvd, Creve Coeur, MO 63141 Unique grocery store. Not as cheap as above, but they have a frozen microwavable Indian dinner (chicken tikka masala, also have vegetarian version) for \$3.49 that tastes wonderful. (An Indian student told us it's very authentic.) Might not be enough food for a meal for some. Can get other stuff with it at this store.

Dierberg's 11481 Olive Blvd, Creve Coeur, MO 63141 Full-service huge grocery store. More expensive, but open more hours (5am – 12am) than Aldi's.

Schnuck's 2030 Dorsett Rd, Maryland Heights, MO 63043, open 24 hours

The loop is home to more than 145 specialty shops including restaurants, galleries, clothing boutiques, gift stores, entertainment, venues, and a boutique hotel.
